Highlights from the Voters Meeting on April, 15, 2014

- Jim Marshall of Marshall Sign provided information to the voters about the digital sign that he has proposed to replace the church sign on Hwy 32.
- Vicar Kuehl got approval to go ahead with his project- having colored flyers printed about Trinity church and sent to 5000 households in 6 zip codes. This would be his mission outreach project for his Vicarage Program. The cost is \$1,575.80.
- The voters approved purchasing the digital sign from Marshall Sign to replace the aging Hwy 32 sign. The cost \$21,875.
- Lutheran High auction brought in over \$123,000 this year. The person that was called for the administrator's position has declined the call.
- The voters approved keeping undesignated memorials for 6 months before dividing it into the appropriate areas.
- The voters approved leasing a postage machine to be used in the church office.
