
PRESCHOOL FOR 2020-2021 WILL BEGIN ON TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 8TH.

Dear Trinity Members,

As you are aware, our church and narthex roof need replacing. At a special voters meeting on June 7, the voters approved moving forward with the project. The work is to begin somewhere around the end of July.
