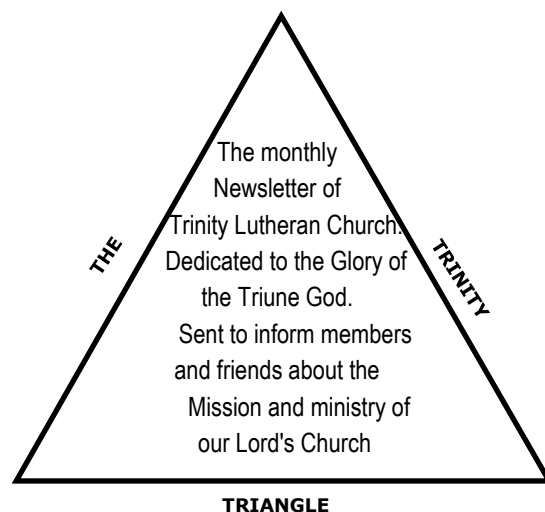
WELCOME Pastor Noah Fremer and Family
