APOSTLES' CREED

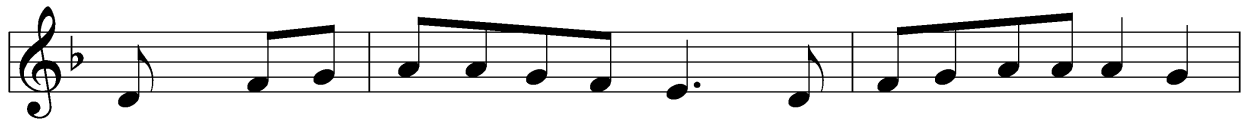
